

# **GRANTS FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE 16th COLLOQUIUM HIPPOCRATICUM**

**Rome, Italy, 25-27 Oct. 2018**

The Organizing Committee of the 16th Colloquium Hippocraticum / Colloque Hippocratique offers 10 grants for younger scholars, PhD students, Bachelor and Master students, and other interested young researchers to foster their participation in the Colloquium, to be held in Rome from the 25th to the 27 of October 2018.

The grant is meant as a contribution to cover travel and lodging expenses for attending the Colloquium. The awardees will be selected by the Committee from among the applications received, and will receive an amount of € 350, to be paid after the Colloquium. They do not have to provide receipts or any other document. They are expected to participate in the three days of the Colloquium, and to take part actively in the discussion.

Successful applicants are requested to fill in the registration form to the Colloquium available online on the website <http://sapereantico.uniroma2.it/xvi-colloquium-hippocraticum>.

Candidates from any country, including Italy, are eligible, provided they do not live in Rome or in Lazio region.

## **Application**

Applications are written in any of the language of the Colloquium (Italian, English, French, German, Spanish, Latin) and are submitted through the Grant Application Form provided online on the website of the Colloquium, including a brief description of the topic in relation to the candidates's research and a motivation of the application. Candidates should also include their CV (with list of publications if available) and, if applicable, the topic of their ongoing Bachelor, Master or PhD thesis.
